


Our girl's football teams played Moira School on Tuesday evening. Unfortunately, they were beaten in both games, but as always they represented us well and did us proud.

- ✓ Black shorts/track suit/jogging bottoms/leggings with black sweatshirt/hoodie. Slogan, logo and picture free please.
- ✓ Trainers

We are happy for your child to wear 'skins' for PE in the colder months, but please do not wear them under uniform on non-PE days.

Children will continue to be asked to come to school in their outdoor PE kit on outdoor PE days- parents might want to consider this when purchasing uniform. In the next few weeks, parents of children in current year 5, will receive a letter via email about the option of purchasing a year 6 hoodie that can be worn on PE days.
