Nut Free School

Please remember that we have some children in school with very serious nut allergies. We are a nut free school and do not allow nuts or nut-based products in school at lunchtimes or at break times. This include chocolate and nut spreads such as Nutella in sandwiches. Thank you in advance for your support.

Latest COVID-19 guidance from the Department for Education- we have several confirmed cases in school, please look out for symptoms.

Adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel
unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough
to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature

- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.
