

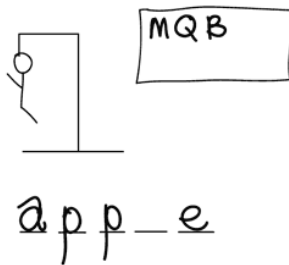
GRAMMAR, PUNCTUATION AND SPELLING GUIDANCE

- ✚ Daily reading will help children recognise common sight vocabulary and spelling patterns.
- ✚ Look for spelling patterns within reading books.
- ✚ Stretch the word to sound it out.



- ✚ Make lists of words with similar spelling patterns.

- ✚ Copy, cover, write & check weekly spellings.
- ✚ Apply spellings within sentences as this is when errors often occur.
- ✚ Use a dictionary and a computer spell check.

- ✚ Dictate shopping lists, birthday wish lists etc, spelling words out for your child to scribe.
- ✚ Pin spellings up around the home - read while brushing teeth...
- ✚ Do word searches, crosswords, hangman etc.
- ✚ Play word games, such as Scrabble, Boggle, Whizzword etc.
