What will happy lunchtimes look like? :

- Zoned area
- New activities
- You will be rewarded for your good choices of behaviour.
- You will be clear about the consequences if you chose make the wrong choices at lunchtime.
- Unchtime supervisors are in charge at lunchtime.
- If you ask a member of classroom staff if you can do something at lunchtime – they will remind you that 'You need to ask a lunchtime supervisor'.

Zoned areas:

- Each day there will be a different activity in the zone.
- There will be one on the KS1 playground and one on the KS2 playground.
- The zone will have a sign to tell you what is happening and which dinner supervisor is in charge of it.
- The main rule of the zone is that everyone is welcome to come and play in it.

Rewarding your good behaviour:

- Happy Lunchtimes Awards in Friday's celebration assembly each of our lunchtime supervisors will nominate one of you to receive a certificate.
- Top Table half termly, lunchtime supervisors will nominate one child from each year group (and a friend) to eat at the top table known as the Golden Table.

Rewarding your good behaviour:

- Pompoms will be awarded by the lunchtime supervisors to you for your good choices of behaviour.
- Chev will be collected in tubes like this.
- Each tube will be for a different merit team.
- They will be compared in Friday's celebration assembly and added to merit team totals.



Consequences:

If you choose to behave badly:

- You will receive a reminder from the lunchtime supervisors.
- If your poor choice of behaviour continues you will be given a 2 minute reflection time - you will apologise to the member of staff.
- If you are disrespectful your reflection time will increase to 5 minutes. You then need to apologise.
- If you continue to make poor behaviour choices you will be brought to a senior member of teaching staff.
- Serious or repeated bad behaviour will result in being brought in instantly to Miss Middleton, Mrs McAuliffe or Mrs Newman.
