In 2017-18 we received £48,180 pupil premium funding which we spent as follows:

- Provision of wraparound care and school milk £400
- ICT and audio equipment £200
- School residential and day trips £1,450
- Provision of swimming £120
- Specialist Teaching Service support, assessments and accessing the curriculum - £50
- HLTA to oversee programmes and run interventions £21,000
- Additional teacher hours for 1:1 support £12,600
- Supply costs for teachers with responsibility for all pupil premium pupils - £3,000
- KS2 SATs intervention £2,000
- Lunchtime support £910
- Educational Psychologist £1,200
- Musical instrument £308
- External S & L training and cover costs £3000

In 2018/19 we will receive approximately £44,000 pupil premium funding which we anticipate will be spent to support the following estimated costs:

- To provide supply cover for the teachers with responsibility for all pupil premium children - £3000
- Provision of wraparound care and school milk- £400
- School residential and day trips £1,500
- Provision of swimming £120
- HLTA time £23,000
- Teacher time for additional 1:1 work £8,000
- Lunchtime support £1500
- Targeted interventions and training to address specific areas of need
 £3000
- S&L Programme £3000
- ADHD solutions coaching £400
