Homework

Reading

Daily reading with your child is one of the most effective ways you can support them at home. Even children who are stronger with their decoding skills need to read regularly with an adult at home in order to develop their comprehension skills such as discussing the meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary. Please sign the reading record each time you support your child. We expect children to read at home with an adult every day for approximately ten minutes. Your child will be read with at least once a week in school.

In Year 1/2, reading will be taught using separate sets of guided reading books, through daily phonics and 1:1 reading where appropriate. Your child will mainly be heard read through our guided reading sessions. It is very helpful to us if your child's reading books and record come into school every day so that they can be used. Each class has their own system in place for checking and changing reading books. On Fridays, children will bring home a 'free choice' book to be shared with an adult to promote a love of reading.

Spellings

In Year 1/2, all children will have a weekly spelling test on a Friday. Your child will receive the spellings they are to be tested on a week before each test. These will not start until later in the Autumn term – more information will be shared with you shortly.

Outdoor and Indoor PE

Your child will have one indoor and one outdoor PE session each week. For indoor PE, children will require a white t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls and a pair of spare socks. For outdoor PE, children will need a t-shirt, long-sleeved jumper/hoodie, jogging bottoms and trainers. Please ensure all items are named including the PE bags themselves. Indoor PE kit will stay in school for the term and be sent home at the end of the term for a wash. On outdoor PE days, your child will come to school in their outdoor kit and remain in that kit for the whole school day.
