

On your child's Outdoor PE day, they may come to school in their PE kit and remain in it for the entire day. They do not need to bring uniform to change into. Homework

Spellings—We will be continuing with our weekly spelling tests. Children will have words to learn each week, following a spelling pattern or the Year 5/6 National Curriculum statutory word list.

Reading—Reading continues to be an extremely important area of your child's learning. We encourage children to read a range of texts to expand their comprehension and vocabulary - ideally at least 4 reads per week at home. To encourage reading, we will continue our popular 4 in a row Bingo sheet. Please ask your child about this.

Moths—Maths homework will be set weekly and will be a combination of paper tasks and online activities on MyMaths. We will be relaunching Times Tables Rockstars in Year 5/6 and will be asking children to log on at home to complete activities to practise their times tables.

We are planning an exciting trip focusing on The Ancient Egyptians at Leicester Museum and Art Gallery on Tuesday 31st October. We will send out a separate letter shortly with further details.
